This listing is designed to help people connect with psychiatrists accepting some of the most common insurance plans in the Austin area. It has two parts.

The first part offers a list of psychiatrists and psychiatric nurse practitioners in private practice in Austin, Texas who accept insurance and offer medication management services.

The second part of this guide provides a list of agencies, clinics and hospitals that offer psychiatric services. Some of these agencies offer services on an income-based sliding scale. Some accept insurance.

You should confirm your insurance coverage before scheduling an appointment.

Counseling and medication work well together.

For the most affordable counseling services in the Austin area:

YWCA offers counseling on a sliding scale that starts at \$5 per session (women, couples & families only).

Capital Area Counseling offers services on a sliding scale that starts at \$10 per session.

We also offer counseling services at Counseling South Austin, a quiet private practice serving 78748 & surrounding areas, on a sliding scale of \$40-\$80 per session.

Many of the providers on this list are not accepting new patients, or they are booking appointments months in advance.

However, if you have gone through this list and the list of providers supplied by your insurance company and cannot get an appointment booked, you still have options:

1.) Community clinics & agencies.

The second portion of this guide includes a number of agencies & clinics offering psychiatric care.

Many of these clinics can bill your insurance or offer services on an income-based sliding scale.

2.) Investigating out of network coverage.

Depending on your coverage, you may have out-of-network benefits that will cover most or all of the cost of treatment.

In these cases, you will need to pay in full at the time of service and then file a statement with your insurance company for reimbursement.

This option offers you more freedom in choosing your provider, though you will likely incur more out-of-pocket expenses.

3.) Single case agreement (SCA).

A single case agreement is a contractual agreement you can develop with your insurance company to work with an out-of - network provider at in-network rates.
